



Greenkeeping Positions

Greenkeeper – Permanent and Seasonal Available

Job Summary

Maintain golf course and landscaping around the golf course, clubhouse and other club facilities.

Experience

- Six months experience in golf course grounds maintenance or greenkeeping is preferred but not essential.

Job Tasks/Duties

- Mow greens and fairways by operating walk-behind turf equipment.
- Perform basic labour on the golf course.
- Basic operation of utility vehicles, sod cutters, weed-eaters, hand-held blowers, small equipment/etc.
- Rake and edge bunkers and periodically fill with sand.
- Repair and maintain driving range tees.
- Clean any/all equipment used on the golf course grounds.
- Aerify and spike greens.
- Perform manual watering on the golf course.
- Prepare and lay sod.
- Plant and maintain ornamental shrubs, trees, and flowers.
- Trim and feed shrubs and trees; removes cuttings.
- Maintain landscape beds around clubhouse and golf course grounds.
- Rake and blow leaves, walkways, parking lots, cart storage areas, driveways, etc.
- Fill divots and repair ball marks.
- Load and unload materials.
- Dig holes and trenches to maintain or construct irrigation and drainage lines.
- Install pipe and backfill excavations.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Perform other appropriate tasks as assigned by immediate supervisor.

Job Knowledge, Core Competencies and Expectations

- Co-operate with, and respect fellow employees.
- Present a professional image at all times.
- Interest in the game of golf is preferred.
- Knowledge of golf course operations.
- Knowledge of irrigation systems.
- Knowledge of and ability to perform required role in emergency situations.

- Regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts and outside weather conditions.
